YOU'LL NEED TO KNOW:

- Buses may come 10 minutes before to 10 minutes after the scheduled time
- Buses may wait only 2 minutes at each pickup
- Eating, drinking, and/or smoking are not permitted on the bus
- Drivers cannot make change
- Passengers must remain seated at all times
- Disruptive behavior may result in refusal of services

NO-SHOW POLICY:

If you miss the bus, or if you cancel your trip less than 15 minutes before your pick-up time, this is considered a noshow. The cost of the missed trip must be paid at the next scheduled ride.

Our mission is to provide safe, dependable transportation for as many people as possible, at a reasonable cost. This is a shared-ride transportation system with specially reduced fares for the elderly and persons with disabilities.

WHERE DOES IT GO?

Buchanan Dial-A-Ride service covers the Buchanan area along with trips to Niles.

WHO CAN USE IT?

All individuals of any age may use Buchanan Dial-A-Ride. Persons 60 and over and persons with disabilities are eligible to use the service for half the regular fare.

Lift-equipped vehicles may transport wheelchair passengers not exceeding a combined weight of 600 pounds (wheelchair, person, and carry-ons).

Reduced fare cards are available though the Dial-A-Ride office at 4676 E. Shawnee Rd. in Berrien Springs, or in the vehicle.
